Eligibility

- Currently teach a construction trade at an NCCER/ABC-VA Accredited Training Education Facility (ATEF), Accredited Training Unit (ATU) or Training Unit (TU)
- Be an NCCER-certified instructor with verification
- Possess a minimum of three (3) consecutive years of experience teaching a construction trade (or equivalent instructor experience)
- Self-nominations are prohibited
- Past winners are not eligible
